### AGES 13-17 AT CHAR-MOUTH







At Teen Camp we aim to offer an exciting holiday with spiritual teaching which will encourage and challenge young people in their faith. This is a great opportunity to meet other Christian teenagers and many friendships last well beyond the summer weeks.

In the morning sessions we look into the Bible – God's message for today – with teaching and discussion. On a number of afternoons, campers choose from five or more activities, ranging from craft and drama workshops to 5-a-side and sea fishing. As we keep the basic fee to a minimum there may be an extra charge for some activities (this depends on choices made. Details will be sent out later).

The evening theme is God's world, where we explore what God is doing in various parts of the world, both here and overseas.

All this plus free time, which gives campers the opportunity to enjoy competitive games on the field, go swimming or just chill out with friends, makes Teen Camp an experience you don't want to miss.

## INFORMATION



#### **Adults**

Adults are needed, both as tent leaders and kitchen helpers. We need keen Christians, willing to give their time and energy, as part of the camp team. Tent Leaders share in all aspects of the programme with the campers. (Leaders: Warrior 18+; Teen 20+. Kitchen team: Warrior 17+; Teen 19+. Leaders or helpers outside these ages are only accepted at the Camp Leader's discretion)

There is a training event for all adults, leaders and kitchen helpers at the end of June – details will be sent out on acceptance of place. It is essential that you attend this particularly if you are joining us for the first time

Helpers are needed to assist in setting up the camp (20th – 27th July) and for packing up afterwards (10th – 12th August). Offers of help are appreciated whether for one or a number of days. No charge is made. Those helping practically at these times are not necessarily expected to attend the camp.

#### **Parties**

Advanced notification of party bookings is helpful. This does not guarantee places. Party leaders may submit unnamed applications provided they are accompanied by the appropriate non-refundable deposit.

#### **Special Offers for Parties**

For every 10 campers booked into WEC Camps we'll give an extra place free.

#### Fees

A non-refundable and non-transferable deposit of £50 must accompany each application.

Warrior Camp: £50 deposit + £135 = £185 Teen Camp: £50 deposit + £145 = £195

Cancellations after 1st July will mean that full fees are due, less the £50 deposit.

Reduced prices for applications received before 1st April 2019: Warrior £170 // Teen £185

(Some optional extra activities may require some additional payment).

Discounts are given for three or more children from one family. Assisted places are available on request.

Adults. We recommend £100 per week or two weeks for £150. (If you can't afford this, don't let it put you off, talk to us in the Youth Office.) Some tent leaders and others sharing in all the activities of camp may wish to give more. This helps us keep the price of camp low. (Any extra money given may be gift-aided).

## **FOR THE PARENTS**

#### **Applications**

Please complete the application form in full. Forms and secure online booking is also available on our website www.weccamps.org

The camper's place is not booked until we have received and acknowledged your written application and deposit.

Age will be reckoned as at 31st August 2019. (Note: we cannot accept children whose age is still only 8 years at the time of camp)

#### **Safety and Security**

The safety and security of your child is very important to us. All campers are accommodated in tents, which usually house three or four young people. Leaders will be housed in adjacent tents to ensure safety and security for your child. Members of Staff are on site at all times and patrol throughout the late evening. In addition we operate a comprehensive child protection policy. (Copies available from Youth Office). All adults are vetted and DBS checked.

The camp staff reserve the right to send home without refund of fees any camper suffering from a health problem of which we have not been previously informed, or whose behaviour is detrimental or disruptive to the camp.

#### **Health Problems**

This section on health is particularly important. Answering these questions will not necessarily prejudice a young person's place, but it will enable camp staff to assist where needed. Answers will be held in complete confidence.

#### **Travel**

Fees do not cover travel to and from camp. Those travelling independently by coach / bus or rail will be met at Axminster railway station.

#### **Camp Life**

Accommodation at camp is in our weatherproof bell tents, each camper is provided with a camp bed, pillow, two blankets and a groundsheet. We provide a varied menu, giving a balanced diet throughout the week.


