<p><b>Saturdays 30<sup>th</sup> July and 6<sup>th</sup> August</b> Leaders arrive. Pray for smooth travel. Saturday afternoon and evening will be a time of orientation, training and fellowship.</p>
<p><b>Sundays 31<sup>st</sup> July and 7<sup>th</sup> August</b> First campers arrive. Pray for safety in travel, especially for those who have to make connections or are travelling alone. Pray that campers and leaders will settle in quickly.</p>
<p><b>Mondays 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> August</b> Pray for the Bible teachers to be inspired by God's Word and put over their message in a vibrant, challenging way. Some campers and leaders have English as a second language. Pray for good integration and understanding. Pray the missionary speakers would be able to share about their work in an interesting way and that eyes would be opened to what God is doing in His world.</p>
<p><b>Tuesdays 2<sup>nd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> August</b> Pray for safety and enjoyment for today. Teens have their first afternoon of optional activities. Pray, too, for the informal discussions on topical subjects at Teens and for quiet times, morning and</p>

<p>evening, at both camps, where young people feel free to express themselves, through prayer times, discussing God's Word and issues that affect them. Pray for good understanding and the Holy Spirit working in many lives.</p>
<p><b>Wednesdays 3<sup>rd</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> August</b> Trip Day for Teens to Cromer. Teenagers given responsibility to go off in groups and enjoy themselves. Pray they will be positive witnesses to those around. Another new feature in this year's programme is the Warrior/Teen combined programme. Today, both Camps will come together for tea, followed by a game/activity and then a time of worship and presentation of the Gospel. Please pray that this goes well and everyone enjoys being together. Pray, too, for a good response to the Gospel.</p>
<p><b>Thursdays 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> August</b> Pray that God would use those casual conversations over a meal, at coffee time or on a walk. Please remember the folk working behind the scenes, particularly in the kitchens. Teens have optional activities again this afternoon.</p>
<p><b>Fridays 5<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> August</b> Last day of the week. Pray that opportunities will not be missed to sort things out in children's lives. Pray for those youngsters who need to get right with God that they would take that step of commitment or re-dedicating their lives to Him. Testimony meetings at both camps.</p>
<p><b>Saturdays 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> August</b> Travel Day - Pray for safety for all those returning home after camp. Pray especially for those with rail connections to make or flying out of the country. Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> - Pray for those preparing the sites for the new week. Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> – Pray for those remaining on site to start dismantling the camp.</p>

<p>Praise God for the arrival of those coming to help take down Warrior Camp and Teen Camp. Please pray each day for fresh bursts of energy, dry weather, safety and protection.</p>

<p><b>Monday 15<sup>th</sup> August</b> Most tents will come down today. Warriors will be loading their equipment onto the lorry to be transported to the warehouse in Coventry. Teens will continue to pack up their camp and get equipment ready for loading.</p>
<p><b>Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> August</b> Teens will be loading their lorry in East Runton.</p>
<p><b>Wednesday</b> Please pray that all the equipment will have been unloaded safely into the warehouse in Coventry.</p>
<p><b>Thursday</b> Campers and leaders are all back home. Give thanks for all those who have been at camp and pray that spiritual seed sown during camp will not be snatched away.</p>
<p><b>Friday</b> Please remember those undertaking post-camp administration and other tasks. Camp 2022 does not end when we leave the field. Pray, too, for the planning for Camp 2023.</p>
