Additional Information

Musical Instruments

If you would like to be involved in the worship team and have a musical instrument, we would encourage you to bring it. There's an opportunity to put a note on the Supervision & Activity form.

Money

There is a camp bank provided to keep your money safe, which can be accessed on a daily basis. We also advise that you make use of the bank to keep important documents safe, such as your passports and travel tickets.

Mobile Phones

Facilities for recharging mobile phones or any other electrical devices are limited. Bring a solar charger if you have one! We advise that mobile phones are best switched off while at camp and left for emergencies only till the end of the week.

Electronic Devices

We advise that you do not bring iPods / tablets or similar devices. These can be easily damaged and can be a source of irritation for others. Alcohol, cigarettes / vapes and drugs of any kind (other than for medical purposes) are **NOT** allowed on the campsite. Please **do not** bring such items with you. Do not bring hairdryers or similar.

PLEASE NOTE: All personal property must be clearly labelled with your name or marked in an identifiable way. It will make it easier to locate owners as we have had an increasing amount of lost property being brought back to the Youth Office after camp. This particularly applies to eating kits.

All personal property is your responsibility unless given to a leader to keep in a secure place.

Camp Rules

We want everyone to have a really great time at camp, but obviously with so many people living close together we can have problems. In order to help the camp run smoothly and in the interest of everyone, we have a few rules. These rules must be kept and campers breaking them may find themselves on the way home.

Three areas are particularly important and so we give you advanced warning:

1. Campers are only allowed off site at specific times and only then with permission from camp staff. Campers do not usually go off site alone.
2. Boys and girls are not allowed in, or near, tents of the opposite gender.
3. Co-operation and respect between everyone on site, the campers and leaders, is expected.

What do I need to bring?

1. Sleeping bag, pillow and pillowcase.
2. Sleeping gear (preferably warm, an emergency pair of bed socks is always a good idea!)
3. Wash kit and towel.
4. At least **FOUR** tea towels.
5. Torch (Don't forget to bring spare batteries!)
6. Knife, fork, spoon, teaspoon, unbreakable plate, cup and bowl and a bag to keep them in with your name on. (We also advise that you mark your eating kit, either with your name or some identifiable mark).
7. Wellies and waterproofs for the rainy days!
8. Trainers.
9. Changes of clothing.
10. Bible, notebook and pen. (These can be purchased for a reasonable price from the onsite bookshop but if you have your own then bring them).
11. Swimming gear (suitable sea shoes could be useful.)
12. At least **TEN** clothes pegs.
13. Optional extras and things to think about... coat hangers, sun tan lotion, sun hat and spare cutlery set.
14. Powerbank / Solar phone charger

Please think carefully about your choice of clothes to wear at camp. It can be embarrassing to others when clothes can be described as, 'revealing'.

It is also important to note that older clothes are preferable for some activities, and essential at the Activity Centre. Open toe sandals or flip-flops are not allowed for some activities so make sure you have trainers packed. It is good to think through your choice of activities at this stage and make sure you bring appropriate clothing.

Travel Arrangements

When do I arrive?

Please arrange to arrive at the campsite after **3pm**. Please examine the travel instructions on the website carefully.

When do you leave?

Please plan to leave the site before **10:30am** on the morning you go home.

Is there anything else?

If you are intending to do activities with other friends, please confer at this stage rather than when you are at camp. To ensure that you have a place on your chosen activities we are asking that you reply via the online Supervision & Activity form asap.
