Here is a reminder of some essential to make you stay on camp even better.

- Torch. (Perhaps even a spare torch)

- Pens/pencils. Notebook
- Swimming gear
- Clothes pegs
- Mirror

- Wet weather gear wellies, waterproofs and over trousers ESSENTIAL.

Bible Teaching Summary Warrior Camp 2022

THEME	Genesis	
Memory Verse Ephesians 2:8-10	8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast. 10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. It will be good to try and learn this before camp.	
Monday	Creation	Please take some time to read Genesis chapters 1 to 16. The Book of Genesis contains some important, including the creation of the universe, the story of Adam and Eve's "fall," the flood, and the building of the Tower of Babel. Genesis introduces us to the patriarchs Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob and Jacob's son Joseph. The main message of the Book of Genesis is the creation of the universe and the Gods connection with the Israelite people. Throughout the text, the themes of creation and covenant demonstrate the connection between the Israelites and God/Yahweh as well as the fact that we humans are unrighteous and deceptive. Genesis describes humanity's downward spiral into actions that were distant from Gods ways. But Genesis also offers a future hope of restoration and redemption. Genesis traces God's covenant and faithfulness to the family of Abraham, showing God's closeness despite their repeated failures.
