

Warrior Camp – East Runton, Norfolk 2022

Dear Parent / Carers,

Thank you for booking into camp, we are really excited to be receiving your child(ren) on Warrior Camp this summer. We have included in this letter some items for your information. There are just a few things that would make your child's time on camp more enjoyable. Please may we ask you to check the list of what to bring to camp on the reverse side of this letter.

May we stress that EVERYTHING needs to be named (in case it gets lost).

This year camp is providing plates and cutlery, so you will not need to send these with your child, we still require them to bring tea towels so that everyone can continue to join in washing up together. Each child also needs a bag, (not a carrier bag), in which to carry their tea towels in. Good waterproofs and wellingtons are essential. We should also like to underline that mobile phones, iPods or similar devices, games consoles, jewellery and other delicate or valuable items should not be brought to camp as we cannot guarantee their safety.

You may wish to provide your child with some money to spend at camp. We have a bookshop and a tuck shop with a range of reasonably priced items. A range of activities included in the price of camp are held both on and off site and there may be opportunities for children to purchase souvenirs etc during these activities. We recommend that children bring about £20-30.00 per week on camp. All money brought to camp needs to be stored in the Camp bank to guarantee its safety.

If you would like confirmation that your child has arrived safely at camp please send a text after 6pm to the following number: 07470 619 200. We will then reply by text.

May we point out that, it is not practical to allow campers to make phone calls. But everyone loves to receive letters and postcards from home.

We are enclosing a letter for your child, as a welcome and an introduction to camp. We also enclose a medical form. This should be completed, brought to camp and handed in on arrival. Please make sure that your child has some protective sun cream as most of the camp programme takes place in the open air.

All campers are accommodated in tents, which usually house three or four young people. Leaders will be housed in adjacent tents to ensure reasonable safety and security for your child. As we are under canvas in a field, safety and security are of utmost importance. Staff patrol through the late evening and there is a member of staff on site at all times. In addition we operate a comprehensive safeguarding policy, a copy of which is available on request from the youth office. It may be possible for your child to share a tent with friends depending on age and tent allocation availability. If you would like to take this opportunity for your child to share with a friend then it is important that we know at least two weeks before your child arrives on camp.

It is also our normal practice for photographs and video to be taken at camp, for use in our future publicity. Usually these are general or group shots with a few individual pictures or interviews. These photographs and video footage will only be used by WEC International or organisations contracted to produce publicity material on our behalf. Photographs will only be taken of children for whom parental consent has been given.

If there is any relevant information about your child that you feel would be helpful for the camp leaders to know, then please drop us a line. If your child is part of a larger group, then the party organiser can do this for you. If your child is not part of a larger group then you should also have received details of how to reach camp.

Please return the Travel Information Form at least seven days before your child is due to arrive on camp. (If before the 19th July then send to the WEC Youth Office. After this date please send to the Camp address)

We do thank you for your co-operation on all these matters. If you would like any further information then please do not hesitate to contact the Youth Office, or alternatively check out the camp website at www.weccamps.org and click on the link to the parents' page. We are praying that your child will have a happy and memorable time at Warrior Camp.

Warrior Camp Kit List

- Bible, pens and pencils (in a case)
- Warm sleeping bag
- **Pillow and pillow case**
- Warm night wear (not dressing gown)
- Wash kit (including: soap, shampoo, toothbrush, tooth paste, baby wipes, deodorant)
- 2 x towels
- 10 x changes of underwear and socks!
- 2 x pairs of trainers
- Pair of wellies or strong walking boots
- A weeks worth of clothes
- Waterproof coat & trousers (essential)
- Swimming gear (suitable sea shoes could be useful)
- Sun cream
- Torch (with spare batteries or self powered)
- 6 x Tea towels
- 10 x clothes pegs
- Small rucksack
- Water bottle
- Strong black bag for dirty or wet clothes
- *Any outstanding medical, consent and activity forms*

IMPORTANT

Please double check you have packed all the **(Essential) kit.**

In order to have a great time on camp it is important that your child/ren bring all the kit listed. We may have a limited supply of spare equipment we can lend should you forget something.

Please note that plates, bowls and cutlery will be provided on Warrior Camp this year, but you will need to bring a pillow.

For Warrior Campers: There is a strict NO ELECTRONIC DEVICE policy, which includes mobile phones. Any mobile phones and electronic devices can be left with the camp office for safe keeping. They will be returned at the end of the week.

For Warrior Leaders: Mobile phones, battery banks and small electronic devices can be brought to camp at your own risk. There is a charging area complete with mains and USB outlets, but usage is limited due to power coming from a generator. Please bring your own charger/cable – we recommend you do not bring large electronics or laptops.

Try to get your entire camping gear into one case or holdall (except sleeping bag).

IMPORTANT: PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL PROPERTY HAS YOUR NAME ON IT!
